A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 15 of Article 6 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to miscellaneous provisions under the "Quality Basic Education Act,"
- 3 so as to provide for a daily recess for students in kindergarten and grades one through five;
- 4 to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Part 15 of Article 6 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 8 relating to miscellaneous provisions under the "Quality Basic Education Act," is amended
- 9 in Code Section 20-2-323, relating to unstructured break time for students in kindergarten
- 10 through grade eight, as follows:

- 12 (a) Beginning in the 2017-2018 school year, each local board of education shall schedule
- a daily recess for students in kindergarten and grades one through five. Such recess shall
- include at least 30 minutes of supervised, unstructured activity time, preferably outdoors.
- 15 <u>Local boards of education shall establish policies to ensure that recess is a safe experience</u>
- 16 for students, that recess is scheduled so that it provides a break during academic learning,
- 17 and that recess is not used as a punishment.
- 18 (b) Each By January 1, 2005, each local board of education shall establish written policies
- allowing or prohibiting unstructured break time for students in kindergarten and grades one
- 20 <u>six</u> through eight. If the policies allow one or more breaks, the policies shall include but
- shall not be limited to the following matters:
- 22 (1) The school personnel who will be authorized to decide the length, frequency, timing,
- and location of breaks;
- 24 (2) Whether breaks can be withheld from students for disciplinary or academic reasons
- and, if breaks can be withheld, under what conditions;

26 (3) How to ensure break time is a safe experience for students, including the responsibility for supervision of students; and

- 28 (4) How to ensure that break time is scheduled so as to provide a support for academic
- learning.
- 30 Local boards shall provide a copy of such policies to the State Board of Education."

SECTION 2.

32 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
