| 7  | OFFICERS SURVIVORS BENEFIT REVIEW BOARD   |
| 8  | (a)(1) There is created the emergency personnel survivors benefit review          |
| 9  | board Emergency Personnel and Law Enforcement Officers Survivors Benefit          |
| 10 | Review Board which shall consist of the state treasurer State Treasurer or        |
| 11 | designee, the attorney general Attorney General or designee, the executive        |

| 8  | (a) The survivors of emergency personnel or a law enforcement officer who               |
| 9  | dies while in the line of duty or from an occupation-related illness may apply          |
| 10 | for a payment of \$50,000.00 from the state State.                                      |
| 11 | (b) The state treasurer State Treasurer shall disburse from the trust fund              |
| 12 | <u>Fund</u> established in section 3175 of this title the monetary benefit described in |
| 13 | subsection (a) of this section, and shall adopt necessary procedures for the            |
| 14 | disbursement of such funds.   |

| 17 | OFFICERS SURVIVORS BENEFIT SPECIAL FUND   |
| 18 | (a) The Emergency Personnel and Law Enforcement Officers Survivors                      |
| 19 | Benefit Special Fund is established in the Office of the State Treasurer for the        |
| 20 | purpose of the payment of claims distributed pursuant to this chapter. The              |

Fund shall comprise appropriations made by the General Assembly and

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- 1 contributions or donations from any other source. All balances in the Fund at
- 2 the end of the fiscal year shall be carried forward. Interest earned shall remain
