1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. 4 This Act may be cited as the "DHS Countering Unmanned Aircraft Systems Coordinator Act". 5 6 SEC. 2. UNMANNED AIRCRAFT SYSTEMS COUNTER-7 **MEASURES COORDINATOR.** 8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Title III of the Homeland Security Act of 2002 (6 U.S.C. 181 et seq.) is amended by adding 9 at the end the following new section: 10 11 **"SEC. 321. COUNTERING UNMANNED AIRCRAFT SYSTEMS** 12 COORDINATOR. 13 "(a) COORDINATOR.—The Secretary shall designate an official of the Department as the Countering Unmanned 14 15 Aircraft Systems (UAS) Coordinator (in this section re-16 ferred to as the 'Coordinator') to coordinate with relevant Department offices and components, including the Office for 17

19 other relevant Federal agencies, as appropriate, on the de20 velopment of policies and plans to counter threats associ21 ated with UAS, including the following:

Civil Rights and Civil Liberties and the Privacy Office and

22 "(1) Countering UAS that may be used in a ter23 rorist attack.

24 "(2) Promoting research and development of
25 counter UAS technologies.

1	"(3) Ensuring the dissemination of information
2	and guidance related to countering UAS threats.
3	"(4) Serving as the Department point of contact
4	for Federal, State, local, and Tribal law enforcement
5	entities and the private sector regarding the Depart-
6	ment's activities related to countering UAS.
7	"(5) Carrying out other related UAS activities,
8	as directed by the Secretary.
9	"(b) Coordination With Applicable Federal
10	LAWS.—The Coordinator shall, in addition to other as-
11	signed duties, coordinate with relevant Department offices
12	and components and other relevant Federal agencies, as ap-
13	propriate, to ensure testing, evaluation, or deployment of
14	a system used to identify, assess, or defeat a UAS is carried
15	out in accordance with applicable Federal laws.
16	"(c) Coordination With Private Sector.—The Co-
17	ordinator shall, working with the Office of Partnership and
18	Engagement and other relevant Department offices and
19	components, or other Federal agencies, as appropriate, serve
20	as the principal Department official responsible for dis-
21	seminating to the private sector information regarding
22	counter UAS technology, particularly information regard-
23	ing instances in which counter UAS technology may impact
24	lawful private sector services or systems.".

(b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of contents in
 section 1(b) of the Homeland Security Act of 2002 is
 amended by inserting after the item relating to section 320
 the following new item:

"Sec. 321. Countering Unmanned Aircraft Systems Coordinator.".
