AN ACT

To amend the Servicemembers Civil Relief Act to allow certain individuals to terminate contracts for telephone, multichannel video programming, or internet access service, and for other purposes.

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2	This Act may be cited as the "Protecting Families
3	of Fallen Servicemembers Act".
4	SEC. 2. TERMINATION OF CONTRACTS FOR TELEPHONE,
5	MULTICHANNEL VIDEO PROGRAMMING, OR
6	INTERNET ACCESS SERVICE BY CERTAIN IN-
7	DIVIDUALS UNDER SERVICEMEMBERS CIVIL
8	RELIEF ACT.
9	Section 305A(a) of the Servicemembers Civil Relief
10	Act (50 U.S.C. 3956(a)) is amended by adding at the end
11	the following new paragraph:
12	"(4) Additional individuals covered.—For
13	purposes of this section, the following individuals
14	shall be treated as a servicemember covered by para-
15	graph (1):
16	"(A) A spouse or dependent of a service-
17	member who dies while in military service or a
18	spouse or dependent of a member of the reserve
19	components who dies while performing duty de-
20	scribed in subparagraph (C).
21	"(B) A spouse or dependent of a service-
22	member who incurs a catastrophic injury or ill-
23	ness (as that term is defined in section 439(g)
24	of title 37, United States Code), if the service-
25	member incurs the catastrophic injury or illness

1	while in military service or performing duty de-
2	scribed in subparagraph (C).
3	"(C) A member of the reserve components
4	performing military service or performing full-
5	time National Guard duty, active Guard and
6	Reserve duty, or inactive-duty training (as such
7	terms are defined in section 101(d) of title 10
8	United States Code).".
