4	ERANS AFFAIRS MEMORIAL HEADSTONES
5	AND MARKERS.
6	Section 2306(b)(2) of title 38, United States Code,
7	is amended—
8	(1) in subparagraph (B), by inserting "who dies
9	on or after November 11, 1998" after "veteran";
10	and
11	(2) in subparagraph (C), by inserting "who dies
12	on or after November 11, 1998" after "veteran".
