## AN ACT

- To amend the National Trails System Act to direct the Secretary of the Interior to conduct a study on the feasibility of designating the Chief Standing Bear National Historic Trail, and for other purposes.
  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

### SECTION 1. CHIEF STANDING BEAR NATIONAL HISTORIC

- 2 TRAIL FEASIBILITY STUDY.
- 3 Section 5(c) of the National Trails System Act (16
- 4 U.S.C. 1244(c)) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
- 5 lowing:
- 6 "(xx) Chief standing bear national his-
- 7 TORIC TRAIL.—The Chief Standing Bear Trail, ex-
- 8 tending approximately 550 miles from Niobrara, Ne-
- 9 braska, to Ponca City, Oklahoma, which follows the
- 10 route taken by Chief Standing Bear and the Ponca
- 11 people during Federal Indian removal, and approxi-
- mately 550 miles from Ponca City, Oklahoma,
- through Omaha, Nebraska, to Niobrara, Nebraska,
- which follows the return route taken by Chief Stand-
- ing Bear and the Ponca people.".
