A BILL

To improve the provision of health care by the Department of Veterans Affairs, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Veteran's Choice Ac-
- 5 countability Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. EVALUATION OF FEE-BASIS CARE PROVIDED BY DE-
- 7 PARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS.
- 8 The Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall evaluate all
- 9 programs of the Department of Veterans Affairs under
- 10 which the Secretary furnishes hospital care, medical serv-

- 1 ices, and nursing home care to determine the most inten-
- 2 sively used specialized care programs of the Department
- 3 and to ensure such programs are maintained as centers
- 4 of excellence.

5 SEC. 3. EVALUATION OF IMPLEMENTATION OF VA BUDGET

- 6 AND CHOICE IMPROVEMENT ACT.
- 7 Not later than two years after the date of the enact-
- 8 ment of this Act, the Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall
- 9 submit to Congress an evaluation of the implementation
- 10 by the Secretary of the VA Budget and Choice Improve-
- 11 ment Act (title IV of Public Law 114–41).

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
