A BILL

- To amend the Small Business Act to require the Small Business and Agriculture Regulatory Enforcement Ombudsman to create a centralized website for compliance guides, and for other purposes.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 - 3 SECTION 1. CENTRALIZED WEBSITE FOR COMPLIANCE
 - 4 GUIDES.
 - 5 Section 30 of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C. 657)
 - 6 is amended by adding at the end the following new sub-
 - 7 sections:

"(e) Centralized Website.—Not later than 6 1 months after the date of the enactment of this subsection, the Ombudsman shall maintain a publicly available 3 website that includes— "(1) hyperlinks to small entity compliance 5 guides described under section 212(a)(1) of the 6 7 Small Business Regulatory Enforcement Fairness Act of 1996; and 8 9 "(2) with respect to each such small entity com-10 pliance guide, the contact information for an indi-11 vidual who can offer assistance to small entities with 12 respect to the rules that are the subject of such 13 guide. 14 "(f) REPORT ON AGENCY COMPLIANCE.—The Om-15 budsman shall include in the annual report required under 16 subsection (b)(2)(C) an assessment of agency compliance with the requirements of section 212 of the Small Business Regulatory Enforcement Fairness Act of 1996 for the
