Mrs. Shaheen introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs

A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to ensure access to acupuncturist services through the Department of Veterans Affairs, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Acupuncture for Our
- 5 Heroes Act of 2019".
- 6 SEC. 2. INCLUSION OF ACUPUNCTURIST SERVICES AT VET-
- 7 ERANS HEALTH FACILITIES.
- 8 (a) Acupuncturist Services.—

- 1 (1) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 17
- 2 of title 38, United States Code, is amended by add-
- 3 ing at the end the following new section:

4 "§ 1720J. Provision of acupuncturist services

- 5 "(a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall carry out a
- 6 program to provide acupuncturist services to veterans en-
- 7 rolled in the patient enrollment system of the Department
- 8 under section 1705(a) of this title (without the require-
- 9 ment of a referral).
- 10 "(b) Locations.—(1) The program under subsection
- 11 (a) shall be carried out in at least one facility of the De-
- 12 partment in each Veterans Integrated Service Network.
- 13 "(2) In selecting facilities under paragraph (1), the
- 14 Secretary shall ensure that the program is carried out in
- 15 both urban and rural areas.
- 16 "(3) If a Veterans Integrated Service Network in-
- 17 cludes a State without a full-service medical center, the
- 18 Secretary shall carry out the program at a facility within
- 19 that State.
- 20 "(c) Services Available.—The Secretary shall en-
- 21 sure that the acupuncturist services available under the
- 22 program under subsection (a) are able to address, at a
- 23 minimum, the following:
- 24 "(1) Chronic and acute pain.
- 25 "(2) Cancer pain.

1	"(3) Postoperative nausea and vomiting.
2	"(4) Postsurgical gastroparesis syndrome.
3	"(5) Opioid-induced constipation.
4	"(6) Opioid-induced pruritus.
5	"(7) Chemotherapy-induced neuropathy.
6	"(8) Aromatase inhibitor-associated joint pain.
7	"(9) Neck dissection-related pain and dysfunc-
8	tion.
9	"(10) Stress management.
10	"(11) Mental health conditions.
11	"(12) Substance abuse.
12	"(13) Symptoms relating to traumatic brain in-
13	jury and post-traumatic stress.
14	"(d) Administration.—(1) The Secretary shall
15	carry out the program under subsection (a) through—
16	"(A) qualified acupuncturists appointed as em-
17	ployees of the Department located at medical centers
18	and clinics of the Department; and
19	"(B) qualified acupuncturists under contracts
20	if—
21	"(i) the Secretary is unable to make ap-
22	pointments described in subparagraph (A);
23	"(ii) a patient requires specialty care that
24	an employee under such subparagraph is not
25	able to provide to the patient; or

- 1 "(iii) there is an emergency that requires 2 the use of such a contract acupuncturist. 3 "(2) The Secretary shall provide training and materials to health care providers of the Department who provide primary care to veterans to explain the benefits of acupuncturist services. 6 7 "(3) In this subsection. the 'qualified term 8 acupuncturist' means, with respect to the furnishing of services in a State, an individual who is licensed or cer-10 tified in the State in which the services are furnished, or, in the case of services furnished in a State that does not provide for such licensure or certification, meets such criteria (such as accreditation through an appropriate nationally recognized certification 14 authority for 15 acupuncturists) as the Secretary may specify. In speci-

fying such requirements, the Secretary may use the same

requirements as those established by such a certification

- 19 "(e) Regulations.—The Secretary shall prescribe20 regulations to carry out this section.".

4	"(I) Acupuncturist services in accordance
5	with section 1720J of this title.".
6	(b) Advisory Committee.—
7	(1) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter III of chapter 5
8	of such title is amended by adding at the end the
9	following new section:
10	"§ 547. Advisory Committee on Acupuncturist Serv-
11	ices
12	"(a) Acupuncture Advisory Committee.—(1)(A)
13	The Secretary shall establish an advisory committee to
14	provide the Secretary with assistance and advice in the
15	development and implementation of the program under
16	section 1720J of this title.
17	"(B) The advisory committee established under sub-
18	paragraph (A) shall be known as the 'Advisory Committee
19	on Acupuncturist Services' (in this section referred to as
20	the 'Committee').
21	"(2) The Committee shall consist of members ap-
22	pointed by the Secretary from the general public, includ-
23	ing—

1	"(A) not fewer than five practicing
2	acupuncturists, of which not fewer than four shall be
3	State licensed acupuncturists;
4	"(B) one veteran from each of the Armed
5	Forces; and
6	"(C) not fewer than two representatives from
7	veterans service organizations.
8	"(b) Duties.—The Committee shall—
9	"(1) review and evaluate the ability of a veteran
10	to access an acupuncturist at facilities of the De-
11	partment;
12	"(2) advise the Secretary with respect to—
13	"(A) protocols governing direct access to
14	acupuncture care;
15	"(B) protocols governing the scope of prac-
16	tice of acupuncture practitioners;
17	"(C) the definitions of services to be pro-
18	vided by acupuncturists; and
19	"(D) such other matters as the Secretary
20	determines appropriate; and
21	"(3) upon the determination of the Secretary
22	that the program of acupuncturist services under
23	section 1720J of this title has been fully imple-
24	mented, submit to the Secretary a report containing

- 1 the evaluation of the Committee on the implementa-
- 2 tion of such program.
- 3 "(c) Chairman.—The Secretary shall designate one
- 4 member of the Committee to serve as the Chairman of
- 5 the Committee.
- 6 "(d) Meetings.—The Committee shall meet at the
- 7 call of the Chairman, but not fewer than three times dur-
- 8 ing each fiscal year, beginning in the fiscal year following
- 9 the fiscal year in which this section is enacted.
- 10 "(e) Report.—After the Committee submits to the
- 11 Secretary the report under subsection (b)(3), the Sec-
- 12 retary shall submit to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs
- 13 of the Senate and the Committee on Veterans' Affairs of
- 14 the House of Representatives a report containing the fol-
- 15 lowing:
- 16 "(1) A copy of the Committee report, together
- with the comments of the Secretary on the report.
- 18 "(2) An explanation of the criteria and ration-
- ale that the Secretary used to determine that the
- 20 program of acupuncturist services under section
- 21 1720J of this title was fully implemented, as de-
- scribed in subsection (b)(3).
- 23 "(3) The views of the Secretary regarding the
- future implementation of such program.".

7	7401(1) of title 38, United States Code, is amended
8	by inserting "acupuncturists," after "chiroprac-
9	tors,".
10	(2) Period of Appointments.—Section
11	7403(a)(2) of such title is amended by adding at the
12	end the following new subparagraph:
13	"(I) Acupuncturists.".
14	(3) Pay.—Section 7404 of such title is amend-
15	ed by adding at the end the following new sub-
16	section:
17	"(f) The position of acupuncturist specified in section
18	7401(1) of this title shall be at the grade of GS-12 or
19	higher under the General Schedule under section 5332 of
20	title 5.".
21	(4) Malpractice and negligence suits.—
22	(A) In General.—Section 7316(a)(2) of
23	such title is amended by inserting
24	"acupuncturist," after "chiropractor,".

1	(B) Effective date.—The amendment
2	made by subparagraph (A) shall apply with re-
3	spect to services provided on or after the date
4	that is 270 days after the date of the enact-
5	ment of this Act.
6	(5) Hours and conditions.—Section 7421(b)
7	of such title is amended by adding at the end the
8	following new paragraph:
9	"(9) Acupuncturists.".

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
