16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 17That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

by the Department authorizing the holder or an agent of the holder to hunt deer outside ofdeer hunting season for the purpose of preventing damage to crops.

3 (2) In Charles County, Calvert County, St. Mary's County, [and] Harford 4 County, AND BALTIMORE COUNTY, an individual who hunts deer under a Deer 5 Management Permit may:

6 (i) Use a shotgun or breech loading center fired rifle approved by 7 the Department to hunt deer throughout the year, including all deer hunting seasons, in 8 the locations and under the conditions set forth in the permit; and

9 (ii) On State land in Charles County, Calvert County, St. Mary's 10 County, [or] Harford County, OR BALTIMORE COUNTY leased by the permit holder for 11 the purpose of cultivating crops, hunt deer on the leased land in the locations and under 12 the conditions set forth in the permit.

13 (3) To protect public safety and welfare, the Department may restrict the 14 lands on which an individual may hunt deer under a Deer Management Permit.

(i) This paragraph applies only in Frederick County.

(ii) Subject to the conditions set forth in a Deer Management Permit,
a permittee may use a rifle approved by the Department to harvest deer throughout the
year, including all deer hunting seasons.

19 (iii) In Frederick County Zone 1, as defined in COMAR 20 08.03.03.06A.(3)(g), an agent of a permittee may use a rifle to harvest deer throughout the 21 year.

(iv) 1. This subparagraph applies only in Frederick County Zone
2, as defined in COMAR 08.03.03.06A.(3)(h).

24 2. Except as provided in subsubparagraph 3 of this 25 subparagraph, an agent of a permittee may use a rifle to harvest deer in a period beginning 26 October 1 and ending March 31.

28 3. In a deer firearms season, an agent of a permittee may
28 harvest deer only by using the weapon approved for that season.

(v) The Department shall adopt regulations to implement this30 subsection.
