A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 19-7-5 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 reporting of child abuse, so as to expand the definition of sexual abuse to include acts
- 3 involving trafficking a person for sexual servitude; to provide for related matters; to provide
- 4 for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 19-7-5 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to reporting of child
- 8 abuse, is amended in paragraph (10) of subsection (b) by deleting "or" at the end of
- 9 subparagraph (H), by replacing the period with "; or" at the end of subparagraph (I), and by
- 10 adding a new subparagraph to read as follows:
- 11 "(J) Any act described by subsection (c) of Code Section 16-5-46."
- 12 SECTION 2.
- 13 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 14 without such approval.
- 15 SECTION 3.
- 16 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
