## A BILL for

1	AN ACT relating to the public safety communications
2	commission; revising commission membership and duties;
3	requiring a report; and providing for an effective date.

5	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

7	Section 1. W.S. 9-2-1102(a)(intro), (xiii), (xiv),
8	(xvi) and by creating a new subsection (d) and
9	9-2-1104(a)(i), (ii), by creating a new paragraph (vii) and

15	(a) The commission shall consist of <del>seventeen (17)</del>

14	Section 2. W.S. 9-2-1102(a)(vi), (vii), (ix), (x),
15	(xv) and (xvii) and 19-13-104(d)(v) are repealed.
16	
17	Section 3. The terms of the members of the public
18	safety communications commission serving pursuant to W.S.
19	9-2-1102(a)(vi), (vii), (ix), (x), (xv) and (xvii) expire
20	on the effective date of this act.

 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
 Constitution.
