A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing March, 2018, as Endometriosis Awareness Month at the state capitol; and for
- 2 other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, endometriosis is a disease of the female reproductive system, which occurs
- 4 when tissue similar to that normally found in the uterus begins to grow outside of the uterus,
- 5 leading to chronic, debilitating pelvic pain; and
- 6 WHEREAS, endometriosis is a leading cause of female infertility and affects one in ten
- 7 women of childbearing age in the United States; and
- 8 WHEREAS, there is an average of a ten year delay from the onset of symptoms to the final
- 9 diagnosis of endometriosis; and
- 10 WHEREAS, endometriosis patients in the United States were hospitalized 105,123 days in
- 11 2010 as a result of their disease; and
- 12 WHEREAS, women with endometriosis can lose 11 hours of work per week through lost
- 13 productivity and absenteeism due to pain; and
- 14 WHEREAS, 51 percent of endometriosis patients report that their disease detrimentally
- 15 affects their job; and
- 16 WHEREAS, the estimated total, annual societal cost of endometriosis-related symptoms in
- 17 the United States is \$56 billion, or \$10,824.00 per patient; and
- 18 WHEREAS, traditionally, providers have focused on managing the associated pain through
- 19 the use of oral contraceptives, progestins, danazol, nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drugs
- 20 (NSAIDs), opioids, and GnRH agonists, many of which are not specifically indicated for the
- 21 treatment of endometriosis; and

22 WHEREAS, in more extensive cases, surgical interventions such as laparotomy or

- 23 laparoscopy are often pursued, but may not be successful for all individuals; and
- 24 WHEREAS, there is no cure for endometriosis, and more research is needed to find
- 25 additional treatment options to manage this debilitating disease; and
- 26 WHEREAS, education is important for promoting awareness of symptoms and early
- 27 detection and diagnosis of endometriosis, and it is abundantly fitting and proper that attention
- 28 be brought to the profound impact that this condition has on women within Georgia and the
- 29 United States as a whole.
- 30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 31 the members of this body recognize March, 2018, as Endometriosis Awareness Month at the
- 32 state capitol.
- 33 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- 34 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
- 35 public and press.
