1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to adjust the period of time requiring the use of lighted
2 front and rear lamps on motor vehicles.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 32-17-4 be amended to read:

5 32-17-4. ~~Every~~ Each vehicle ~~upon~~ on a highway ~~within this state~~ during the period from a
6 ~~half hour after~~ sunset to a ~~half hour before~~ sunrise and at any other time when there is not
7 sufficient light to render clearly discernible any person on the highway at a distance of ~~two~~ three
8 hundred feet ahead; shall be equipped with lighted front and rear lamps for the different classes
9 of vehicles as respectively required in §§ 32-17-1 to 32-17-26, inclusive, ~~for different classes~~
10 ~~of vehicles and subject to exemption with reference to lights on parked vehicles as declared.~~ If
11 the vehicle is parked or stopped on a highway, the vehicle shall be equipped with lighted front
12 and rear lamps as required in § 32-17-27. A violation of this section is a Class 2 misdemeanor.
