FOR the purpose of establishing the State Innovation Fund as a special, nonlapsing Fund; 4 5 specifying the purpose, use, and contents of the Fund; requiring the Secretary of 6 General Services to administer the Fund; requiring the State Treasurer to hold the 7 Fund and the Comptroller, in conjunction with the Secretary, to account for the 8 Fund; providing for the investment of money in and expenditures from the Fund; 9 providing that the accounts and transactions of the Fund shall be subject to a certain 10 audit: requiring the Secretary to establish the State Innovation Program in 11 accordance with certain requirements; requiring certain information regarding the 12 Program to be posted on a certain website; establishing certain requirements 13 regarding the payment of and reimbursement for monetary awards; exempting the 14 Fund from a certain provision of law requiring interest earnings on State money to accrue to the General Fund of the State; and generally relating to the establishment 15 16 of the Student Innovation Program and Fund.

- 1 (A) HALF OF A MONETARY PRIZE AWARDED UNDER § 4–1203(B) OF THIS 2 SUBTITLE SHALL BE PAID BY THE STATE AGENCY THAT SUBMITTED THE 3 SOLICITATION.
- 4 (B) A STATE AGENCY MAY COMPLY WITH SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION 5 BY:
- 6 (1) PAYING HALF OF THE MONETARY PRIZE DIRECTLY TO THE 7 INDIVIDUAL OR ENTITY THAT SUBMITTED THE SOLUTION; OR
- 8 (2) REIMBURSING THE FUND FOR HALF OF THE MONETARY PRIZE 9 AWARDED FROM THE FUND.
